- Assist Director of Sports Development & Competition in identifying and recruiting coaches around the state.
- Work directly with Director of Sports Development & Competition to develop statewide sports plan.
- Attend state games and be available for oversight of rules enforcement, challenges and protests.
- Ensure all Special Olympics Alaska coaches adhere to coaching standards set forth by Special Olympics Incorporated.
- Identify statewide coaches' needs and develop coaching training calendar.
- Conduct sports clinics and meetings.
- Ensure compliance to the rules, policies and standards of Special Olympics Alaska.
- Ensure all health and safety guidelines related to sports training are followed.
- Advise and assist local programs in recruiting coaches, establishing and conducting local level training and/or invitational competitions.
- Evaluate sports program planning and implementation processes annually.
